Ms. Frances Doak worked in the banking business from 1948 to 1994. She held banking positions that were once unheard of for women. She helped pave the way for women in banking in Oklahoma.

Frances Doak was born September 8, 1928 in El Reno to John and Mary Doak, but has been a Chickasha resident since the age of three. She attended St. Joseph's Academy and Chickasha Public Schools, as well as taking in a year at the Oklahoma College for Women.

Doak worked for First National Bank and Trust Company of Chickasha for 46 years, and has been a member of the bank's board of directors for approximately 24 years. She intends to retire from that position this year.

A member of Holy Name Catholic Church, she has served a term on the parish council. She served also as secretary-treasurer of the Brookridge Townhouse Association. She worked with the Chamber of Commerce in Chickasha, served on the Girl Scout Board and been active in the Heart Association.

Doak's main project is the Chickasha Mobile Meals program. She was in charge of the volunteers and delivers meals three to four times a week.

Frances Doak was inducted into the Chickasha High School Hall of Fame in 1987.
