Construction is underway on the Grand Avenue Elementary Library Saferoom. Dirt work and the pad have been completed, and piers have been installed for additional structural support. The foundation trench will be dug on December 17, with foundation work to follow.

At Lincoln School Intermediate Center, construction has begun on the new gym. Dirt work is complete, the pad is ready, and pier installation will begin soon, followed by foundation work.

Renovations at the Early Learning Center are nearly complete. The building has a new roof, fresh exterior paint, and interior painting is nearing completion. A new privacy fence has been added, trees have been trimmed, and minor fence adjustments made. Select rooms will receive new flooring, security cameras and access-controlled doors are being added, and the main office will receive a new counter, cabinets, and updated storefronts at the main entrance and hallways.
